OVERVIEW

The Quest Incubator (QI) program provides a yearlong opportunity for students to launch a startup or nonprofit. Working closely with dedicated mentors and industry leaders who guide them through the creative process, students learn to architect, develop and reiterate their product in the marketplace in order to gain traction, revenue and seed funding. Working collaboratively in teams, students learn how to project manage, effectively communicate, problem-solve, and develop creative solutions for real-world application.

The purpose of QI is to develop business-minded students who will innovate, collaborate, and launch their startup ideas to fulfill their God-given call to create and transform the world around them. Silicon Valley entrepreneurs, industry leaders, and mentors guide and encourage these students to be the next generation of faith and purpose driven principled leaders.

Students have access to seminars, workshops, and round-table discussions as well as the opportunity to actively network and consult with entrepreneurs and mentors on developing their business plans into a startup seeking seed funding. Students practice their pitches through DEMO Day presentations, student-led workshops and networking opportunities.

Quest Incubator is available to students who participated in President's Business Challenge (PBC) or DECA, or who have comparable experience. To be considered for this highly selective program, students need to submit the program application and include a cover letter, resume, and two references.
