## **DESCRIPTION OF EXCELLENCE**



## SOCIAL SCIENCE DEPARTMENT FACULTY

Our Social Science Department faculty includes ten teachers with master's or doctoral degrees; the average instructor has taught at VCS six years.

- The Social Science Department participates in VCHS' Dual Credit Program, which allows students selecting certain classes to take those for college credit.



#### SOCIAL SCIENCE COURSES

Three years of social science are required to graduate from VCHS and the history requirement is specifically met with a world history course, US History, and Economics and Government. Students choose one class either freshman or sophomore year, take a US History course their junior year and one semester each of Economics and Government in their senior year.
